#### Athletic Fee

 For all "non-cut" sports, payment if required at time of sign up. For any "try-out" sports payment is required once athlete makes the team. Finance office will verify receipt of payment. Some Scholarships are available. Requirement of scholarships: Must qualify for free or reduce lunch, 2.5 GPA, no failing grades on most recent report card. Please inquire in Athletics Office for paperwork.
