Discussion Notes:	Future Eagle Night – an important event for SRHS as it centers around increasing enrollment. The Team would like to come up with ideas that will make it more successful.
Conclusions:	Promote Future Eagle night by dispersing fliers to schools where there could be potential enrollment for SRHS.
Action Items:	Spring Fling is an example of our next outreach activity – March 21 st is the tentative date. A suggestion was made to send fliers to Dietz, and various charter and middle schools to promote engagement and attendance. Also the FG Team agreed to allocate \$500 towards the cost of security for the Spring Fling.
