Hello Eagle Families!

Testing season is officially underway! Our state adopted the ACT as our official statewide assessment. We will be administering the ACT on Wednesday, April 2nd to all 11th graders during the regular school day. As part of the adopted ACT Suite of Assessments, our 9th graders will take the ACT Aspire test on Wednesday, April 2nd, as well. *Completion of these tests for 9th and 11th graders is mandated by the State of Arizona at a 95% participation rate.*

Due to the testing of both 9th and 11th graders for most of the school day, regular classes will not be scheduled. All 10th and 12th graders will be excused and marked "School Business" for attendance. Non-testing students are expected to complete asynchronous assignments or coursework from home, if applicable. Should 10th and 12th graders choose to attend school during testing, Learning Spaces (supervised, independent classrooms) will be available. We anticipate testing will conclude by 2:30 pm and will provide learning spaces for students until dismissal.

Students must use school-issued devices for all state required testing. Please have your student bring their charged laptop and charger.

Upon arrival on Tuesday, April 2nd, all 9th and 11th graders will report directly to their CREW class.

Important Note: ACT does not allow any personal devices to be accessed during the entire testing session (8:00 am – 2:30 pm). This includes cell phones, tablets, and personal laptops.

Important Information About the Tests: Both the ACT and ACT Aspire are required by the Arizona Department of Education.

ACT (11th Grade)

The ACT is a standardized test designed to measure high school students' general educational development and their ability to complete college-level work. The questions on the ACT test the core subjects that students typically study through their third year of high school (English, reading, mathematics and science). This exciting opportunity gives our students a chance to measure their readiness for life after high school, whether they're going to college or into the workforce.

Your student will create a MyACT Account as part of their non-test experience. Please encourage your student to complete all questions, including listing up to four colleges where they can send their scores for free, before the test.

Are you aware that having your student opt into ACT's free Education Opportunity Service (EOS) provides them with these great opportunities?

1. **Positions them ahead of the curve.** EOS gives you and your student access to test scores 11-14 days faster than waiting for your paper report.
2. **Empowers their plans.** Your student will be able to sign up to have up to six colleges receive their test scores as soon as they are available, the first four are FREE! (2 days post testing)!
3. **Unlock your child's potential.** Answering all questions in MyACT provides more college and career planning information that will link to their report, sparking great college-going conversations.

ACT Aspire (9th Grade)

With the ACT Aspire, you can get useful information to help your child choose the right high school courses, think about ways to work on areas for improvement, and even begin discussions about their college and career interests.
