REPORTS TO REVIEW	Spring Assessments Season and Supports – Just had winter benchmark and have state assessments for April 1st. This is the biggest testing day for ACT and ASPIRE. Also have AzSci and TSA testing that are coming up. Test scores directly impact school scores. The testing days are structure no cell phones, we provide snacks during testing and a fun

In exchange for their sponsorship Santa Rita will provide a banner to demonstrate a partnership between the two entities.</p> <p>2. Enrollment/Outreach Summary *Goal*</p> <p>We held our Future Eagle Night on 1/22, and when looking at our SMART Goal it is very beneficial and practical. We have done a lot of outreach this year and a lot of site visits to other campuses and had several 8th graders come and take tours. We also gave tickets to our basketball game on FEN to 8th grade students. It was very well organized and ran well, but the parent/student turnout has been disappointing. Sana Rita is looking to find some other way to draw students and parents. On March 4th TUSD is offering a Step Up program district wide where students can come to campuses that they are interested in attending. The issue becomes that the Step Up program is from 4:30-6:30 so it may be difficult to visit multiple campuses during the two hour window. Ms. Case has led the way in offsite campus visits to middle school campuses. Ms. Case states that LaPaloma Academy is a promising relationship for SR. LaPaloma has invited SR to an event on their campus. Perhaps having students from SR go and ready to students and to specifically invite parents to come to March 4th. The other school is Sonoran Science Academy is also another school who is very receptive to working with SR on enrollment. They are also an AVID school. Sylvia R states that she works at Divinci Tree Academy and that Coach Hale and Coach Smith brought the tickets to the SR basketball game to Divinci Tree Academy to promote the game. Ms. Case asked Ms. Reynoso to secure the contact information for Divinci Tree so that she may contact them for visitation.</p> <p>Enrollment – getting ready for graduation as it is getting closer! That means its time for budget meetings. SR’s meeting is 2/24. Ms Ray has been meeting with departments to determine staffing. For the 25/26 enrollment SR is the only school whose enrollment did not decline. 😊 Projected enrollment 407 26/27. The current senior class has 64 students and that should be on the lower side moving forward. 117 sophomores, 89 juniors, 84 freshmen. Only about 25% have completed registration. During spring sports night we will ask parents to complete registration and the School Quality Survey. SR will be working to secure those students through registration.</p> <p>'26-'27 Updates – SR we will be the first school in the county to offer a pathway to an AGECE!!! During 4th quarter meeting to go over details.</p> <p>Summer Bond Updates/ Relocation</p> <p>SR is scheduled to receive a new sewer and water line. As a result we are relocating for the summer to Palo Verde. All summer school and athletics will be relocated to Palo Verde while construction is underway at SR. Move day is the 22nd of May, that is when supplies are moved to the new location at Palo Verde. SR has been told that transportation will be provided for our (SR) students since we have been relocated to Palo Verde. Tentative return date is July 13th, the following week is Reg Fest. Ms Ray has submitted a letter to the bond oversight committee to review the decision to not provide Santa Rita with a state of the art facility by not improving the football field from grass to turf and to repair/replace the track to ensure safety for all our athletes. The other concern is that SR will be at a disadvantage when all other east side schools have state of the art facilities except for SR. To date the committee has not responded to Ms. Ray via email, letter or in person. The meeting date is set for February 19th.</p>
